Volunteer Opportunities

All of our social service programs rely on the efforts and energy of generous volunteers. The commitment can be as easy as a couple of hours per month. Many of our volunteers enjoy their work so much that they contribute on a daily basis. The choice is yours and is very much appreciated by so many.

Home Delivered Meals – Meals on Wheels

A hot, delicious and nutritious meal is delivered Monday through Friday (except on holidays) to seniors, and those that are homebound, disabled or recovering from surgery.

The meals are delivered by our volunteer drivers between 10:30 AM and 1:00 PM.. Recipients may request to be a member of the Breakfast Club/Weekend Program. This provides seniors with a brimming grocery bag delivered with Friday's meal. Drivers are asked to commit to at least one day per week or be on call as a substitute driver. Ask us for a clearance package which is approved by the Department of Public Safety.

Community Lunch

All in the community are invited to join us in our dining hall for a delicious, nutritious, hot meal. They can enjoy the friendly atmosphere, meet with and make new friends. Our volunteers serve meals, greet diners or help with kitchen clean up. A food handler's card is required for all but greeters. There is a free (for volunteers) class held at 10 S. 6th St. Cottonwood, AZ in the Municipal building on Tuesdays at 3:30pm. Card is issued at the end of the class. Bring proof of legal residency such as a Driver's license. Early registration is not required.

Telecare

Our Telecare program provides peace of mind that comes with daily telephone calls to individuals in need of a wellness check. It is available 365 days a year and is free of charge to Sedona area residents. We are able to offer this service due to a cadre of dedicated, caring, and concerned volunteers. Each volunteer calls the list of clients one day per week.

Mail, Special Events

From time to time we need volunteers to help us plan and execute special events, do fundraising, garden, create bulk mailings, organize food pantry and help package the Breakfast Club/Weekend Program grocery bags.

Concierge

We need someone to sit in our lobby and greet and direct visitors. This is a fun and rewarding way to meet and assist people.
